## **POLICY RESOLUTION #16 – Jonathan Association Board of Directors**

RE: Architectural Review Committee (ARC) Approved Updated

Regulations

## While acknowledging that:

1. The current ARC guidelines do not cover if a homeowner is found in violation of the ARC policies or those who proceed without ARC approvals.

## <u>In addition to establ</u>ishing that:

- 2. When a homeowner is found in violation of the ARC policies and covenant violations via a filed neighbor complaint, the following will occur:
  - a. Notification will be sent to the homeowner indicating the violation and subsequent resolution
  - b. The homeowner will have 30 days (60 days for structural items as noted in the notification) to resolve the violation
  - c. If the violation has not been resolved within 30/60 days, a \$10 per day fine will be assessed on a monthly basis
  - d. The homeowner is responsible for informing the Jonathan Association when the violation has been resolved
  - e. The Jonathan Association will inspect the property within seven days of notification or when reasonably feasible
  - f. Should the violation continue to be observed, the fine would be retroactive from the point of reporting completion to the Jonathan Association
  - g. Should the violation be remediated, the fine would stop as of the point of reported resolution to the Jonathan Association
- 3. If the homeowner has questions related to the letter or violation, they may attend the next Board meeting if it is within the 30/60 day grace period or call the Association
- 4. Subsequent same or repeat violations within one year would not have a grace period and would incur an immediate fine
- 5. Unresolved and/or unpaid balances after 30/60 days may be sent to collection and subject to applicable fees and are considered delinquent at day 31/61.
